These questions are about the development of castles	
Motte and Bailey	1. This castle had several walls

	4. This castle was made out of wood.
Shell Keep	5. It was quick and easy to build and there were plenty of forests in England.
	6. It was easily set on fire by burning arrows
	7. This castle had a courtyard and a ditch around it
Concentric Castles	8. This castle was round with one wall
	9. The canon was introduced in the late 1400's could easily blast through this castle's many walls.
