Using source A and your own knowledge describe Search and Destroy tactics used by the US 8 marks

- “we started to move through the village, shooting everything in sight, children, men , women, and animals. Some was sickening. Their legs were shot off and they were still moving. They were just hanging there. I didn’t fire a single round and I didn’t kill anyone. I couldn’t”
- Taken from Bilton and Sim (1992) Four Hours on My Lai

Target: Use of source and knowledge to describe key features

Using source A and your own knowledge describe Search and Destroy tactics used by the US 8 marks

- Candidates either submit no evidence or fail to address the question. **0**
- **Level 1: Basic description, using source or own knowledge**
- e.g. the sources tells us that people had their legs shot off.
- e.g. everything in sight was shot **1 -2**

- **Level 2: EITHER**
- **Detailed description of limited aspects**
- e.g. detailed description of one of the following aspects of the campaign 'Search and Destroy' , reference to the use of helicopters or CIA informants, targeting Vietcong suspects, use of torture, specific detail from My Lai including source content
- **OR**
- **Limited description of wider range of aspects**
- e.g. covers a range of detail including My Lai and several points from above

- **Level 3: Detailed description of several aspects using source and own knowledge**
- e.g. at least two aspects described in detail, from the list in level 2 **6-8**
