Assessment Activity 7 – One final bombshell!

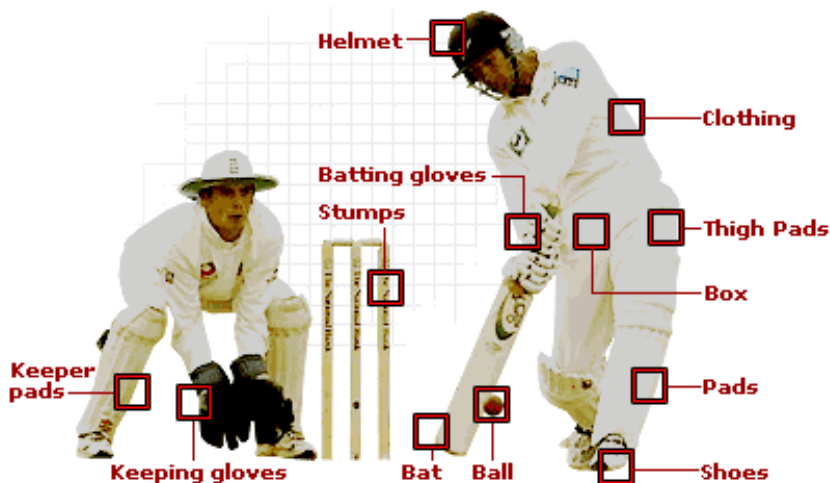
Your risk assessment and contingency plans make regular reference to range of specialist equipment that will be needed on the day of the event...to get the participants and staff safe from injury.
