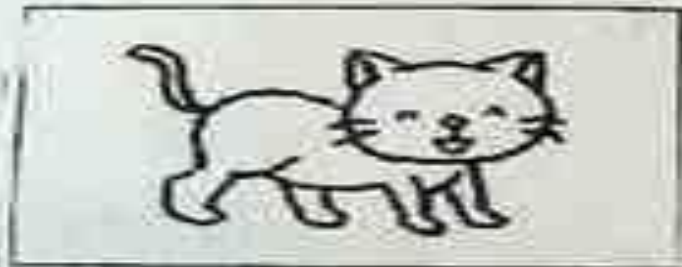

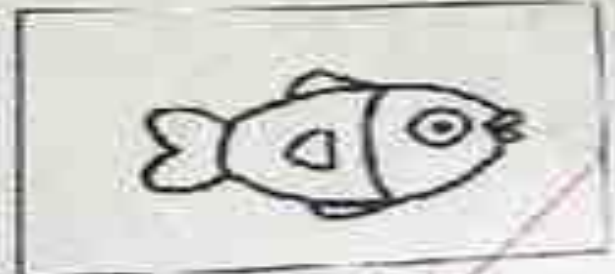



The (d) questions

These questions ask you to give **YOUR OPINION**.

(i) You must give **3 REASONS** why you agree OR disagree.

(ii) You must give **3 REASONS** why some people might disagree with **YOUR** opinion.



Remember to split up your arguments... one part must agree and the other must disagree.

You **MUST** include some religious beliefs/teachings in at least one of the sections to get fill marks.

The (d) questions

How are they marked?

Its SIMPLES...

These type of questions are worth **6 marks**.

These questions are split into **TWO** parts - (i) & (ii)...

Each part is marked out of 3 - you get **ONE** mark for each point you make.

The (d) questions

Example:

"All religious parents should make sure their children believe in God."

In your answer you should refer to at least one religion.

~~((ii) Give your answer. Some people may disagree with you.~~

I disagree because I think everyone should make their own decisions when it comes to religion, as well as they can and teaching them about God makes their children morally good people.

1 mark given for ONE reason

It also goes against their basic human rights to have the freedom to choose their religion. Christian parents also believe that it is their duty to raise their child to follow their religion and teach them about God.

2 marks given for ONE reason

Also many religions people make promises during their wedding ceremonies to raise any children they have to follow their religion so it is important to do so. It is like brainwashing and would go against the idea of free will.

3 marks given for ONE reason

I agree because it is not just up to the government, they have put in place things like the Race Relations Act but is up to the general public to help promote and follow this.

(i) Give reasons why some people may disagree with you.
(3 Marks)

Some people might disagree with me as it is up to the government to lead people in gaining community cohesion. They need to make the laws on racism tighter.

In your answer you should refer to at least ONE religion.

(i) Do you agree? (3 Marks)

I disagree because it is up to the government to put the necessary things in place to ensure society can achieve community cohesion. They should provide necessary funding to groups and organisations promoting this and ensure people are made accountable for racially motivated crimes.

(i) Give reasons why some people may disagree with you. (3 Marks)

Christians may disagree with me as they feel that they have a religious duty to promote racial harmony and help achieve community cohesion. Christians believe that they should follow the teachings of the bible and Jesus that everyone is equal and community cohesion does this.

In you answer you should refer to at least ONE religion.

(i) Do you agree? (3 Marks)



I agree because it would be impossible for the government to do this alone, society must get on board and help. The government can put things in place like the Britishness test and can make it legal for community cohesion to be taught in schools but if society don't get on board these things simply dont work. As a Christian I also feel it is my religious duty to help the government tackle this issue. I look to the Bible and the teaching of Jesus which promote equality and peace. In the bible it teaches that 'man was created in the image of God' therefore all humans are equal in God's eyes no matter what their race. Promoting community cohesion follows this teaching.

(i) Give reasons why some people may disagree with you. (3 Marks)

Some people may disagree with me as they feel it is the governments sole responsibility to promote community cohesion and tackle instances if racism. The government are responsible for the society in which we live therefore it is them only with the power to achieve community cohesion. The government are also responsible for setting up and funding groups that help promote community cohesion, highlighting their ability to achieve such. The government are also responsible for passing laws such as the Race Relations Act, that have helped and will continue to help community cohesion to be achieved.

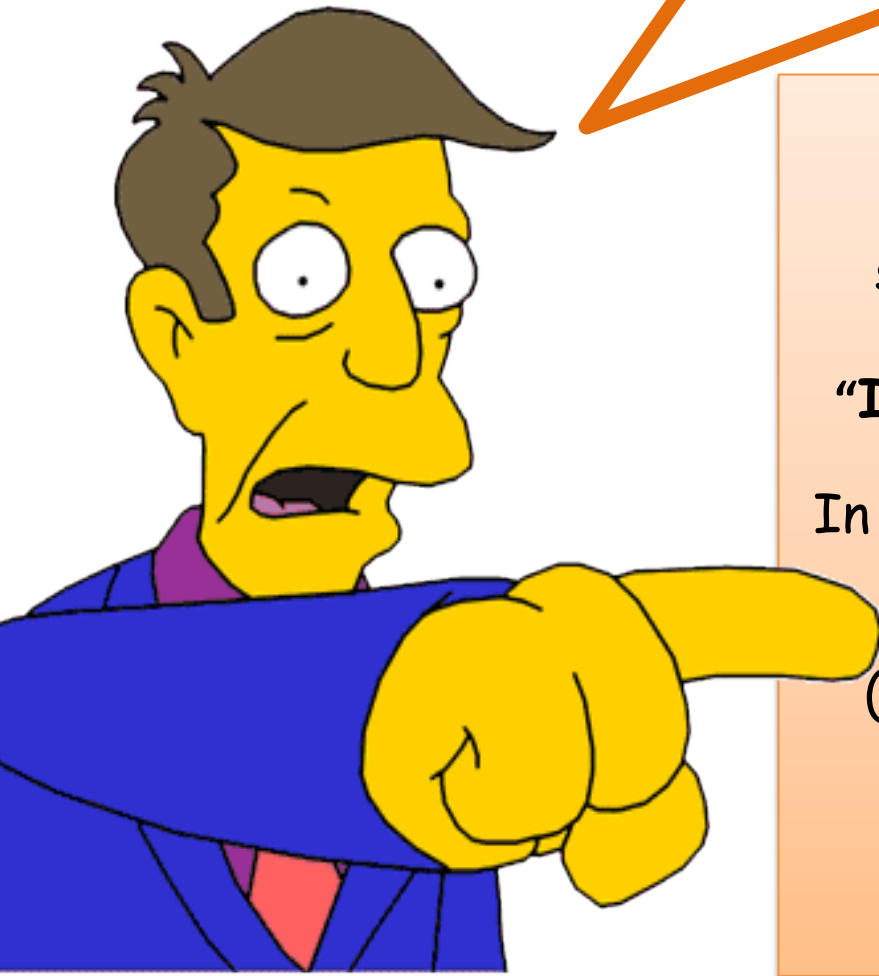
