

Before the big exams

Draw up a revision timetable and stick to it.

Be realistic, no-one can revise for four hours at a time without a break.

Allocate perhaps one hour at a time for each subject.

Use one of the active revision methods suggested to summarise the topic and come back to it later.

Read your notes again before the exams to refresh your memory.

Equipment

Find out what equipment you will need for the exam.

Put it all into a clear plastic bag or pencil case.

Equipment list:

(This is the **minimum** you will require for an exam, you will need additional items for some subjects e.g. compasses and protractors for Maths)

Black pen

Spare pen

Pencil

Sharpener

Rubber

Ruler

Calculator
