

# Changing lessons

- Millthorpe has lots of different classrooms for lessons. Students will move around the school to different classrooms.



- Each lesson lasts one hour.



- When it is time to move on to the next lesson the teacher will prepare students for this by asking to them pack away their belongings.
- Before I put my planner away it is a good idea to check where my next lesson is. This is a good thing as I may need to ask for help finding the classroom. Students should do this quietly and listen out for the bell to ring, which signals the next lesson. Your teacher will tell students when to leave the classroom.
- Millthorpe is a big school and it might take me a few weeks, sometimes more, sometimes less, to find my way around. This is ok. Most students have difficulty finding their way around at first. There is usually someone to help me find where I am supposed to go. I can always go to the ISC and ask for help or use my map.
- It is OK to be late for lessons if students can't find their way. Teachers expect that students might be late in the first few weeks of school.
