

Introduction

International Basketball Services has a long tradition of organising Basketball Camps for young people. The BE A PLAYER Basketball Half Term, Easter and Summer Camps are now in their 20th year and are a good experience for beginners and the more serious player. The Be A Player programme is system of developing youngsters with the skills to become a good basketball player. Basketball is a great sport but long term success depends on a young player being able demonstrate the basic techniques and skills of the game and each camp is designed to allow players to

- Improve their basketball skills and fundamentals
- Learn how hard work can contribute to success and what success means
- Develop their ability to work in a team
- Appreciate the importance of self discipline and self motivation
- Enhance each players enjoyment of the game by giving them a structured environment that rewards good fundamentals, hard work and team play whilst at the same time having some fun !

Costs

For a Camp Day there is a charge of £15 (York Eagles registered players receive a £5 discount and pay £10). For the Easter Camp the charge is £40 for the 3 days or £15 per day and £15 for the one day Advanced Camp (£5 discount for York Eagles registered players who pay £10 per day, £25 for 2 days and £35 for 3 days.)

Daily Schedule

Players register on the 1st day from 9.30 am and the Camps start at 10 am. The day consists of stations (activities) to improve fundamentals, mini tournaments and games. The Camp day finishes at 4.00 pm with Awards on the last day of each Camp. Drop offs from 8.45 am and pick ups to 5 pm on each day are offered if required
