The Mathematics Department currently consists of six full time and one part time member, all with a wealth of experience, and includes a Head and Assistant Head of Department. The team is very supportive of each other and take a collaborative approach to teaching and learning. We are looking for an exceptional teacher who is able to contribute to the team with opinions on best practice grounded in research.

We are a forward thinking department who has recently implemented a new scheme of learning in both Key Stage 3 and 4. This approach incorporates the increased hours we have at Key Stage 4 and the mastery approach we are undertaking across all year groups. The Department is on a journey to implement and use manipulatives effectively for all year groups. Currently Key Stage 3 receives three hours of teaching per week, with Key Stage 4 receiving 4 hours. Year 7 students are streamed and set from Year 8.

The department has six specialist teaching rooms, all equipped with interactive whiteboards. There is a dedicated Mathematics office.
