YEAR 9 TRIP TO YORK UNIVERSITY : TUESDAY 6 MARCH

This year, we will be taking all Year 9 students to York University. The purpose of the visit is to give students first-hand experience of a successful and respected University to raise their awareness of higher education options and help them make informed decisions about the best route for them beyond Millthorpe. Students will tour the campus and take part in activities designed to improve their understanding of Higher Education and the application process.

Students will be visiting in two groups: your son/daughter will be attending on Tuesday 6 March with the rest of the North half of the year.

The trip will depart at 9.30am and return by approximately 3.00pm. Students will travel to the site by coach accompanied by a group of staff.

Students need to arrive at school for registration. They do not need to wear school uniform but should dress appropriately for a visit of this nature.

Lunch will be provided but students may wish to bring a drink and/or snack with them. A variety of food is available for students to choose from, including vegetarian options. If you prefer, please feel free to send them with a packed lunch.
