Students have been given an individual copy of this timetable, with their specific exams marked. Their copy also includes their exam number, the room(s) they will be seated in for their exams and a brief overview of the school's expectations around punctuality, equipment and conduct.

- Arrive at your exam room 15 minutes before the start of your exam.
- Check the seating plan before the start of your exam to find your seat.
- Seating plans are located on the doors to B4, B5, main hall and the gym. They are also located on the windows of the B4/B5 corridor facing into the main yard.
- If you are seated in B4/B5 or the gym take your bag and coat to that room. If in B4 or B5 you will leave your bag and coat in the storage room at the front of these classrooms. If in the gym you will leave your bag and coat in the changing rooms.
- If you are seated in the main hall leave your bag and coat in B1.5 before going to the hall. There will be signs around the room indicating where each form should place their possessions. Once you arrive in the yard outside the main hall line up in front of the letter that indicates which column you are sat in. You will enter the main hall in columns.
- Phones and watches must be left at home or left in your bags. Under no circumstances must these be taken into the exam rooms.
- All equipment must be in a clear pencil case. You are required to bring a black pen, pencil, rubber, ruler, pair of compasses, protractor and calculator.
- You are allowed to bring in a bottle of still water. The bottle must be clear and unlabelled. You are not permitted to bring any food into the exam rooms.
- Ensure you know what your candidate number is.
